Project title: The Jyväskylä Longitudinal Study of Personality and Social Development (JYLS).

Major goals: To follow the significance of emotion and behavior regulation for interindividual differences in socioemotional behavior and for individuals' development in personality, education and career, psychological and social functioning, health and health behavior, and antisocial behavior from age 8 through ages 14, 20, 27, 36, and 42 to age 50. Data collection at age 60 has been organized by Katja Kokko, Research Director at Gerontology Research Center, University of Jyväskylä.

Sample: 12 randomly drawn second grade school classes: N = 369, 52% males, born 1959 Role: Principal Investigator (Lea Pulkkinen) until 2012
