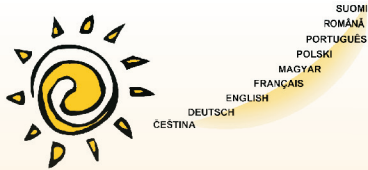


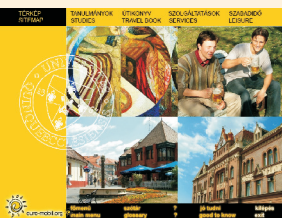
Learning Hungarian with EUROMOBIL

- **Webforum** for discussion

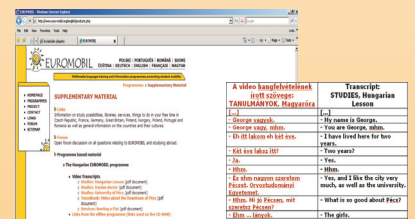
