

Student Card

In order to utilise (-il-iz-) the services (-t-i-) available (-bil-) to members of the Student Union (for example, discounts offered by the railways, buses and airlines, campus cafeterias, theatres, exhibitions (-it-ion-) etc.), you should obtain a student card.

Obtaining your student card

An application (-a-t-ion-) for a student card is included in the information (-a-t-ion-) package sent to you together with the letter of admission (-s-ion-). Return the application (-a-t-ion-) form to the International (-t-ion-al-) Office before your arrival to Jyväskylä. If you sent the form to the International (-t-ion-al-) Office within the deadline, you can collect your student card from the Student Union Office (Building Y, next to the student restaurant Ilokivi) soon after the term has begun. The price of the card is EUR 10.

Degree students - validating (-a-t-) your old student card

The student card may be validated (-a-t-) for each subsequent academic (-ik-) year in the Office for Student Affairs and Services (Administration (-a-t-ion-) Building, 2nd floor) or in the Student Union Office (Ilokivi- building) after you have paid the Student Union membership fee with the personal reference (-nt-i-) number. If you would like to collect the sticker (-ari-) for the student card, the student calendar (-ari-) and the study guides immediately (-a-t-) after having paid the fee, remember to take the receipt of the payment with you.

PhD students

PhD students and visiting PhD students may apply for a PhD student card if they wish. Please note that this has to be done when registering to the university (-s-tat-) at the beginning of the academic (-ik-) year/term. With the PhD student card you are entitled to a small discount in many student cafeterias. You may also use the services (-t-i-) of the Finnish Student Health Service (-t-i-) (YTHS).
